## JeriPole Fishing Adapter Kit

Maximum fishing line breakage test strength is 6lbs.

Recommended fishing line breakage test strength is 4lbs.

Stresses above maximum line test strength increase the risk of damaging your trekking poles.

Do not hike with the JeriPole pole tip adapter attached to the trekking pole. The pole tip adapter is not intended to withstand trail impacts. After being used for fishing, the pole tip adapter should be removed and replaced with an accessory such as a mud basket, which also serves as a thread protector.

The JeriPole adapter kit includes:




Flexible rod extension
Pole tip adapter
Line guide
Fly Reel mount
Spinning/Underspin reel mount

- 1) Clean trekking pole tip threads and attach the pole tip adapter.
- 2) Extend trekking pole lower tip section and lock in place. Do not extend pole beyond the 'stop' mark.
- 3) Remove trekking pole upper handle section from middle section. The handle section is not used.
- 4) Insert flexible rod extension into pole tip adapter.
- 5) Snap on Line Guide to trekking pole middle section.
- 6) Place reel foot into Reel mount socket and snap onto trekking pole middle section.
- 7) Align reel and eyelets for smooth fishing line travel.


Handle Section (unused)

When done fishing, remove the JeriPole components and reassemble your trekking pole. Confirm the pole locks are secured according to your pole manufacter's instructions.

While hiking, the flexible rod extension can be stowed inside the trekking pole middle section.
